**16<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time** ~ Jesus shares a series of parables on the Kingdom of Heaven beginning with one about the sowing of seeds. In this one both good and bad seed is sown. The slaves of the householder want to pull out the weeds but the Master of the house counsels to let them grow up together, then harvest them and separate the good from the bad. The next two parables are also about growth: the mustard seed; and the yeast that causes the wheat to rise (grow). Jesus notices that growth comes in many ways. There is the parallel growth of good and bad, there is the surprising growth of something tiny (the mustard seed) that becomes something very big, and there is the growth that comes when something full of potential (yeast) is added. Growth usually is very slow and incremental. It is hardly noticeable. Over short periods, one usually cannot see it happen. But tracked over a long period of time, it often shocks and amazes us. Some people mark the growth of their children on the borders of the hallway doors on a monthly basis. Days or weeks probably cannot be recorded. Monthly or quarterly will reveal the growth that has occurred. Do we recognize our personal growth as Christians – as Catholics? Do we stop to take a good look at ourselves and appreciate the way the Gospel has grown within us? Do we mark the growth along the way, perhaps through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, or through good talks and sharing with other people concerned with the growth of their own spirit? Jesus lifts up the notion of **GROWTH** because He knows that the grace and love of God so generously given and so fruitful for our spirit offers us the opportunity to experience tremendous growth. **16<sup>o</sup> Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario** ~ Jesús comparte una serie de parábolas sobre el Reino de los Cielos, comenzando con una sobre la siembra de semillas. En ésta, ambas semillas se siembran; buena y mala. Los trabajadores quieren arrancar la hierba mala, pero el Maestro de la casa aconseja que crezcan juntas y al llegar la cosecha, separar lo bueno de lo malo. Las siguientes dos parábolas también se refieren al crecimiento: la semilla de mostaza; y la levadura que hace que el trigo suba (crezca). Jesús nota que el crecimiento viene de muchas maneras. Existe el crecimiento paralelo de lo bueno y lo malo, existe el crecimiento sorprendente de algo pequeño (la semilla de mostaza) que se convierte en algo muy grande, y existe el crecimiento que viene cuando se agrega algo lleno de potencial (la levadura). El crecimiento suele ser muy lento y gradual. Es apenas perceptible. Durante períodos cortos, uno por lo general no lo percibe. Pero siguiendo la trayectoria, a menudo nos sorprende e impacta. Algunas personas marcan el crecimiento de sus hijos en los marcos de las puertas del pasillo cada mes. Probablemente no se registran los días o semanas. El crecimiento que se ha producido se revelará mensual o trimestralmente. ¿Reconocemos nuestro crecimiento personal como Cristianos? como Católicos? ¿Hacemos un alto para echar un buen vistazo a nosotros mismos y apreciar la forma en que el Evangelio ha crecido dentro de nosotros? ¿Señalamos el crecimiento a lo largo del camino, tal vez a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación, o a través de buenas conversaciones y el compartir con otras personas preocupadas por el crecimiento de su propio espíritu? Jesús levanta el concepto del **CRECIMIENTO** porque sabe que la gracia y el amor de Dios tan generosamente dados y tan fructíferos para nuestro espíritu nos ofrece la oportunidad de experimentar un tremendo crecimiento. Durante meses, durante años, durante toda la vida — simplemente sorprende! **"El Reino de los Cielos se parece ... el Reino de los Cielos está cerca ... el Reino de los Cielos está aquí hoy!"**

If we look at our rivers and lakes, our oceans and skies, our soil and just about everything we have, we probably would admit that we abuse and misuse our many resources. Stewardship is also about our use of money – our material resources. We pray each week to be good stewards so that we can learn to manage and use ALL of our resources with care and in a faithful way.
