

16th Sunday Ordinary Time ~ Jeremiah speaks of shepherds who 'mislead and scatter the flock'. Through the Prophet, God not only sees the evil that has been done, He promises to gather 'the remnant of the flock' and to appoint new shepherds who will shepherd them so that they can fulfill the promise He made to them: "*there they shall increase and multiply*". In the Gospel, the Apostles had been appointed to 'shepherd' the people. They went forth, sent by Jesus, to teach and heal and were even given authority over unclean spirits. Now, Jesus seeks to spend some quality time with his disciples to listen to their experiences and to share what they had done. The crowd would not allow them to have any time alone – they kept coming, so hungry were they for the words of Jesus. So, Jesus took his Apostles to a place even more deserted to spend some time sharing with them. The hungry crowd followed and even arrived before the disciples. When Jesus saw them, He noted that they were 'like sheep without a shepherd'. Again, He began to teach them. Jesus always went the extra mile to give them not what they wanted, but what they needed. Like sheep without a shepherd, He shepherded them with words, with compassion, with love, with truth. We usually spend most of our time focusing on what we give to the Lord, how we love Him, what we need to do for Him. These readings make it quite clear that the most wondrous things have been done and are being done again by the Lord **for** us and **to** us. This living Word of God gives us the confidence to proclaim: "*The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.*"

Viene un tiempo, dice el Señor, en que haré surgir un renuevo en el tronco de David — Jeremías 23:5a



16 Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario ~ Jeremías habla de los pastores que 'dispersan y dejan perecer a las ovejas'. A través del Profeta, Dios al ver el mal que se había hecho, promete reunir "*el resto de mis ovejas*" y nombrar nuevos pastores que las apacienten para que puedan cumplir con la promesa que les hizo: "*para que ahí crezcan y se multipliquen*". En el Evangelio, los Apóstoles habían

sido enviados a 'pastorear' a la gente cuando fueron enviados por Jesús a predicar y a sanar y les dio autoridad sobre los espíritus inmundos. Jesús trata de convivir con sus discípulos para escuchar sus experiencias y compartir lo que habían hecho. La multitud no les permitiría tener un momento a solas - seguían llegando, tenían tanta hambre de las palabras de Jesús. Así que Jesús llevó a sus Apóstoles a un lugar aún más desierto para compartir un tiempo con ellos. La multitud hambrienta les siguió e incluso llegó antes que los discípulos. Cuando Jesús los vio, se dio cuenta que eran "*como ovejas sin pastor*". Una vez más, se puso a enseñarles. Jesús siempre se esfuerza al máximo para darles no lo que ellos quieren, sino lo que necesitan. Como ovejas sin pastor, Él los pastorea con palabras, con compasión, con amor, con la verdad. Solemos pasar la mayor parte de nuestro tiempo enfocados en lo que le damos al Señor, cómo lo amamos, y que tenemos que hacer por Él. Estas lecturas dejan en claro las cosas más maravillosas que se han hecho y que se siguen haciendo día a día por el Señor **por** nosotros y **para** nosotros. Esta Palabra Viva de Dios, nos da la confianza para proclamar: "*El Señor es mi pastor; nada me falta*".

Come and join us in our Eucharistic Celebrations **INSIDE** the Church.

Although fully vaccinated people have relaxed guidelines, it is still mandated that when at businesses and in crowded venues both inside and outside, masks are still required. So, at Masses, we will continue to wear masks and attempt to distance ourselves and, of course, to sanitize our hands and our facilities.

The Archbishop also gives his full approval to a return of our celebrations inside the church and while live-streaming may continue, the Archbishop strongly encourages people to return to live celebrations as there is nothing to compare to actual presence with one another and at the actual Eucharistic Table of the Lord.

Choirs will NOT resume at this time. Limited singing with primarily a cantor is to be the rule still at this time. Hopefully by August we will be able to return to the more normal at that time. If it becomes abundantly clear that we can return sooner – we shall.

Finally, as our Holy Father Pope Francis (after receiving both vaccinations) has encouraged us to do, it certainly is my hope as your Pastor that you would do all that you can to receive the vaccinations and put both yourself and others at minimal risk. Thanks be to God having been taking names and phone numbers and noting where people have been sitting at Mass, we have not seen evidence of even '1' case of the Covid 19 coming from our assembled celebrations. We thank God for the good health of all of our people and pour out our hearts and our prayers to those who have lost family and friends to Covid 19. May God, in good time, heal and bring to peace those who have suffered loss and illness during this time.

Gracias a Dios que se han estado tomando nombres y números de teléfono y observando dónde se han sentado las personas en la Misa, no hemos visto evidencia ni siquiera de '1' caso del Covid 19 proveniente de nuestras celebraciones congregadas. Agradecemos a Dios por la buena salud de toda nuestra gente y va nuestro corazón y nuestras oraciones por aquellos que han perdido familiares y amigos por Covid 19.
